Scholarship Application

The student applying for the Columbiana County Federation of Conservation Clubs Scholarship must be eligible for graduation as a high school senior, or a student in good standing if currently enrolled in higher education. The type of higher education selected may be a university, college, technical school, or certificate program. The selection of this award will be based on scholastic record, future plans, motivation for learning and career readiness, leadership initiative, financial need, and commitment to the future of outdoor conservation. Applicants must indicate their major field of study in Natural Resources, Wildlife Conservation, Wildlife Biology, Environmental Science, Forestry, or a similar related field. Applicants may re-apply for this scholarship up to a maximum of four (4) times over the duration of their education.
