NEWS RELEASE APPRENTICE OPENINGS

The Ironworkers Joint Apprenticeship Program is currently accepting applications for a new class of Ironworkers. The following is the wage progression for Iron Worker Apprentices:

1 st year Apprentice:	\$18.80 per hour + \$19.06 in benefits
2 nd year Apprentice:	\$21.69 per hour + \$19.06 in benefits
3 rd year Apprentice:	\$24.58 per hour + \$24.00 in benefits
4 th year Apprentice:	\$27.47 per hour + \$24.62 in benefits

Upon completion of the 4 year apprenticeship program, the current pay rate for Journeymen Iron Workers is **\$28.92** per hour with an additional **\$25.24** in benefits (i.e. Pension & Medical)

Applicants must include the following items with their application:

- A. Transcript of high school grades or GED test scores**
- B. Military Service Certificate of Completion (DD-214) (if applicable)**
- C. Valid Driver's License**

Basic Qualifications

1. At least 18 years of age
2. High School Graduate or Equivalent
3. Physically capable of performing work of the trade
4. Be able to pass a pre-employment drug screen & physical
5. Driver's License and Transportation

An aptitude test and an agility test will be administered some time after an application has been submitted. Selection of apprentices under this program shall be made on the basis of qualification alone and all applicants will be afforded equal opportunity under these standards without regard to race, color, creed, sex, sexual orientation, disability, genetic information, age, or national origin. This information is forwarded to you in compliance with the selection procedures of the training program, approved and registered by the Ohio State Apprenticeship Council.
