Sigma Alpha Epsilon Fraternity, ΣAE (or SAE) awards two scholarships (in the amount of 2 - \$500, and 4 - \$250) to the applicants who most closely reflect the characteristics of our creed, the True Gentleman, stated above. The mission of ΣAE is to promote the highest standards of friendship, scholarship, and service for our members.

A few years ago, a Brother of the Ohio Nu chapter was involved in a tragedy while doing the thing he loved most. Tim Allison, a senior student at UT, and a dedicated member of our organization, was just doing the one thing that made him happy, playing with children as a camp counselor in North Carolina. One day while swimming and watching over the students in the water, Tim wandered away from the group of children and was struck by a boater who did not see him. This boating accident not only was a huge shock to his family, but also to his family away from home; his brothers of the Fraternity.

Following this event, and losing a great person and asset to the Fraternity, ΣΑΕ, decided to give back in a way that Tim could always be remembered, not only by his family but also by his brothers. Board, Blue Key, and numerous professional fraternities. We participate in community events such as the ALS Walk of Toledo, UT Dance Marathon, Adopt-a-Highway, Songfest, and community clean-ups.

We place heavy emphasis on scholarship and our dedication has paid off. This scholastic effort has been recognized by The University of Toledo, Office of Greek Life where we received a Dean Parks Award for Academic Excellence. Additionally, Sigma Alpha Epsilon placed second amongst all fraternities on campus with a chapter average of 3.134 during Fall 2018.
